<b>Requirements</b>	<p><b>Implementation of Strengthening Education Systems in East Africa (SESEA) Baseline Survey in Lindi</b></p> <p>Aga Khan Foundation in collaboration with CIDA co-funded the SESEA project with a core objective of sustainably improving learning outcomes focusing on literacy and numeracy for pre-primary and primary level student.</p> <p>AKF required undertaking a well-organized SESEA Baseline Survey Project in the districts of Lindi rural, Kilwa and Nachingwea in Lindi region. The baseline utilized nationally approved standardized Snapshot of School Management Effectiveness (SSME) and Early Grade Reading Assessment (EGRA) &amp; Early Grade Mathematics Assessment (EGMA) tools.</p>
<b>Solution</b>	<p><b>Training, Tablet-based Data Collection and professional services from DataVision International</b></p> <p>The project embarked with an intensive training workshop session in Lindi which involved all the stakeholders such as supervisors, assessors, among others.</p> <p>The training was followed up by an intense 3-Week tablet based Data Collection from the teachers in the prescribed schools.
